Here are some Biblical Deacon Selection Guidelines. A deacon should....

- **Be of honest report – honorable and worthy.**
- **Be full of the Holy Ghost – known to be spiritual.**
- **Be wise.**
- **Be grave – serious minded.**
- **Be not double-tongued – a man of his word.**
- **Be not given to much wine – not a drunkard.**
- **Be not greedy of filthy lucre – not overly materialistic.**
- **Hold the mystery of faith in a pure conscience – a believer in Jesus Christ.**
- **Be the husband of one wife – individual interpretation.**
- **Rule their children and house well – be the head of a Christ-centered home.**

Here are some Duties of an Active Deacon. A deacon should....

- **Maintain a reputation for integrity in the community.**
- **Be available for assistance to church members in times of need.**
- **Support as many activities of the church as possible.**
- **Deal with the business interests of the church.**
- **Be alert for opportunities of service at the church.**
- **Pray for the church membership, church staff, and pastor.**
- **Promote harmony and fellowship in the church.**
- **Seek God's guidance in all decisions regarding the church.**

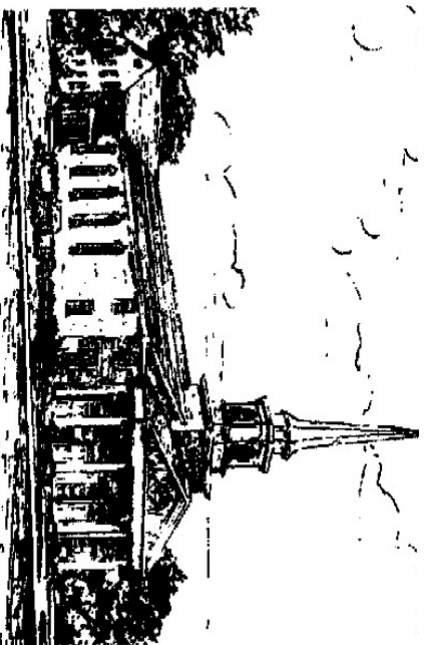
